PAVILION

- PAVILION IS SHOWN AT 1,500 SF
- EVENT SEATING CAN HOLD 150 TO 180 GUESTS DEPENDING ON SETUP
- PROVIDES COVERED SPACE FOR STUDENT PROJECTS
- PAVILION INCLUDES STORAGE CLOSET AND OUTDOOR SINKS

(D) RESTROOMS

- MASTERPLAN SHOWS 8 RESTROOMS AND 2 HANDICAP ACCESSIBLE RESTROOMS
- SEPTIC INSPECTION AND PERMIT TO BE EXPLORED PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION
- STYLE AND LAYOUT OF RESTROOMS AND PAVILION RETAIN ARCHITECTURAL FIRM
- CAPACITY IS BASED ON OSHA REQUIREMENTS AND AVAILABLE PARKING



F EXPANDED MEETING SPACE

- ADDITION DOUBLES CAPACITY FOR LECTURES, AND MEETING SPACE
- CONNECTED TO MAIN ENTRY FOR EASY TICKETED EVENT MANAGEMENT
- PROTECTS THE ADJACENT JAPANESE MAPLE
- ACCESSIBLE FROM NORTH AND SOUTH ENTRIES

MEW EXIT ONLY AND SECURITY GATE

H) TOUR BUS AND SCHOOL BUS LOOP

- BUSES ENTER AT SOUTH ENTRANCE (M) AND DROP PASSENGERS OFF
- ALL BUS TRAFFIC EXITS BULLINGTON ONTO UPPER RED OAK TRAIL

OVERFLOW PARKING

- GRADING REQUIRED TO ENABLE POSITIVE DRAINAGE
- ESTIMATED 20-25 SPACES DEPENDING ON DISPLAY BED LOCATIONS

(J) EXISTING GARDENS AND STRUCTURES

EVENT LAWN

- LEVEL INFORMAL LAWN SPACE FOR OUTDOOR EVENTS (MUSIC, FUNDRAISERS, ETC.)
- TENT RENTAL OPTION TO COVER INCLEMENT WEATHER
- WALL AND PLANTINGS CREATE SENSE OF ENCLOSURE/PRIVACY


ARBOR
